A once in a lifetime event happened to a vast portion of Quadrant One. The pictures below are some of the local astrological wonders captured by members. Unless you were able to view it firsthand, words and/or pictures can't do it justice!





Red Squadron was the designation given to Cadet Training Squadron 47 (CTS-47), an elite group of cadets at Starfleet Academy. Red Squad members received special classes and advanced field training.

In 2372, the program was a relatively new idea. A group of Red Squad cadets, including Riley Shepard, disabled the global power distribution center in Lisbon, allowing Admiral Leyton to launch his coup attempt. (DS9: "Homefront", "Paradise Lost")

It is likely the idea was conceived after Nova Squadron's fall from grace under Nick Locarno in "The First Duty".

Shortly before the outbreak of the Dominion War, Red Squad was assigned to crew the USS Valiant, on a training mission to circumnavigate the Federation. Following the outbreak of war, the Valiant found itself trapped behind enemy lines. When the ranking officers were killed, Cadet Tim Watters was given command of the Valiant by the late Captain Ramirez, and kept the ship behind enemy lines. For eight months, Red Squad carried out the missions assigned to the Valiant, until, Stardate 51825, on the Valiant engaged a Dominion battleship prototype. The ship was lost, with only three survivors - one Red Squad cadet among them, Dorian Collins. One of the other survivors, Ensign Nog, concluded that Red Squad was an overall good crew whose inexperience caused them to blindly follow an unqualified and incompetent commanding officer. (DS9: "Valiant")


